Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM)

celebrated its 20th anniversary with the theme "We Can Build Safe Online Spaces". During SAAM, Fearless! highlighted the importance of prevention, intervention, and recognition of sexual assault with a social media campaign.





On April 28th, Fearless! Staff joined Peace Over Violence in their global Denim Day Campaign. Denim Day asks everyone to make a social statement by wearing jeans as a visible means of protest against the misconceptions that surround sexual violence. This movement was in response to a rape conviction that was overturned in 1998 where the Italian Supreme Court Judge ruled, "Because the victim wore very, very tight jeans, she had to help him remove them, and by removing the jeans it was no longer rape but consensual sex". Enraged by the verdict the women in the Italian Parliament came to work wearing jeans in solidarity with the victim.

On April 1st, the **Rape Intervention Services and Education (RISE)** program transitioned to Fearless! Our Fearless! Sexual Assault Advocates co-located within Garnet Health Medical Center can support individuals of all ages in Sullivan County who are or have been a victim of sexual violence or assault with:

- Accompaniment to ER, police station, and court
- Individual crisis counseling
- Support Groups
- Advocacy
- Information and referrals
- Education to youth and community groups

Our dedicated staff and volunteer advocates are available to help and provide information 24/7 to support anyone suffering the physical, emotional, and medical impacts of rape and other sexual trauma. We know that domestic and sexual violence are often overlapping; both are rooted in power and control and intersect with other forms of oppression. The ability to leverage existing programming and services within Fearless! will enhance and expand sexual assault services to victims and survivors throughout Sullivan County. This not only supports our mission as an agency, but it will also strengthen and streamline advocacy on behalf of all survivors and victims.
