



END HUMAN TRAFFICKING

The Safe Harbor To-Go Bags Program was created to provide anyone who is being trafficked or vulnerable to being trafficked with helpful items and safety tools. Each bag contains items such as snacks, a change of clothes, and toiletries. These bags are meant to decrease a young person's vulnerability and support them in safety planning and harm reduction. Locations such as A Friend's House Youth Shelter and Center for Hope would have these bags available to youth.

Label the outside of the bag with the clothing size it contains.

*small, medium, large, or extra large

Backpack (Any Style, Color)

- Socks
- Gender Inclusive Pants, T-shirt, and Sweatshirt*
- Wet Wipes
- Brush
- Mini First Aid Kit
- Snacks (granola bars, chips, fruit cups, and does not require a can opener or cooking)
- 2 Water Bottles

In a Large Ziploc Bag

Travel Size Items

- Toothpaste
- Toothbrush
- Shampoo
- Conditioner
- Soap
- Deodorant
- Hair Ties
- Face and Body Lotion In One

In A Separate Ziploc Bag:

- 1 Pair of Panties*
- 1 Pair of Boxers*
- Tampons
- Pads
