I am Little Red A FILM SCREENING & DISCUSSION

I AM LITTLE RED is a 10-minute animated short aimed at children most at-risk for sex trafficking (e.g. foster-care, runaway, LBGTQ, homeless, and adopted children), with the goal of prevention and awareness. It is a contemporary re-imagining of the classic fairy tale, Little Red Riding Hood and addresses the four tactics a "wolf" (trafficker/pimp) will typically use to lure a Little Red off their path.

This film was created especially for middle school students (ages 11-14) of all genders. When coupled with the teaching guide's plan, it is a primary prevention tool aimed at reducing the risk of commercial sexual exploitation among children. By seeding entire grades within a school system or age groups within a community, a teaching session involving I AM LITTLE RED can be an important part of an inoculation approach to commercial sexual exploitation.
