In Their Shoes

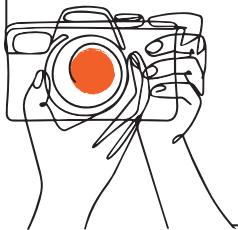
Thursday, February 16, 2023 • 3:00pm - 4:00pm
